Components to include in your application

- Full Name
- Current Street Address
- Current Email
- Current Telephone Number
- Parents or Legal Guardians' Names
- Morell Credit Union Member Number
- Current High School
- Post-secondary institution you will be attending
- Name of the program you will be taking
- List any other scholarships or bursaries you will be receiving
- Confirmation if you will be applying for a student loan to help finance your education.
- A bio about yourself (maximum 500 words) that includes:
 - educational accomplishments (awards, honors, sports, committees, etc.);
 - community involvement; and,
 - why do you feel you are deserving of a credit union scholarship or bursary?
- A copy of your reference letter from a teacher or community member
- Proof of acceptance to the post-secondary institution
- A copy of your transcripts.

Please note the following

1. Failure to provide the necessary documentation will result in the disqualification of your application.
2. By submitting your application, you release to Morell Credit Union, its agents, and employees all rights to exhibit this work in print and electronic form publicly or privately and to market and sell copies. Furthermore, you waive any rights, claims, or interest you may have to control the use of your identity or likeness in whatever media used; and you understand that there will be no financial or other remuneration for recording you, either for initial or subsequent transmission or playback.
3. In submitting this application, you are declaring that to the best of my knowledge and belief, the required information supplied is correct and complete in every aspect. That any monies issued based on this application will be used only for valid educational expenses associated with your post-secondary studies. If for any reason, you do not complete your first year of post-secondary studies, you will return any of the unused portions of the scholarship to the credit union.
4. If for any reason, you do not attend university or college in the year the scholarship/bursary was awarded, the funds, in full, will be returned to the Morell Credit.
